Kentucky Changers Volunteer Information

What is Kentucky Changers?

Kentucky Changers is a coed mission experience for youth and adults. It combines free labor with local agencies to make a difference in a community. Kentucky Changers seeks to impact the lives of participants by mobilizing them to be On Mission Christians.

Kentucky Changers History

Kentucky Changers is a program modeled after World Changers that is sponsored by the North American Mission Board. It came into being as a means of mobilizing youth and adults to be on mission in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Over 1,000 participate each summer and have their lives challenged and changed through this ministry. Following the 1994 start in Hopkinsville, Kentucky, Kentucky Changers has grown into multiple projects. We currently offer All Youth, Collegiate Age, and All Adult projects.

What are some of the responsibilities of the Ministry Team?

The Ministry Team will be a team of 6-9 members who are college age and will do a lot of the behind the scenes setting up and tearing down for Changers projects. Each team member will have a role in nightly worship and be on hand to lead devotion for youth groups as requested. Team members will serve along side the youth on the jobsite each day. The Ministry Team will serve as a role model and will be on hand to minister to students during free time each night.

What are some of the qualifications for a Ministry Team member?

Must be a born again Christian with a solid and growing relationship with Jesus Christ.

Must be active in a local Baptist church

Must be living a lifestyle that honors Christ

Must be active in Missions within your church, community, or state.

Must have a strong and growing prayer time and quiet time with God each day

What expenses will Kentucky Changers Cover?

Ministry Team Members will have free meals and lodging and Kentucky Changers will reimburse mileage for trips to and from the projects and around the project sites during the week of the project.
