Prepare a gift bag with the following items: a picture of your house, a cup, a box of cereal, a set of clothes, and a piggy bank

Welcome the children to church today! Thank them for coming up front. Make sure that they can see the bag, but not what is inside the bag.

Ask them if they know the difference between wants and needs. Tell them that you brought a bag full of needs today. Carefully take each one out, one at a time and talk about why this item is a need.

Explain to them that some people do not have everything they need. Open your Bible and read Matthew 25:34-40. Jesus said that when we help others it is just like helping Him.

Each of us can help. We can give our money, food or time to help others. We can pray.

Lead in a prayer asking God to remind us to help others.
