

Have you thought about starting a Christian-Based Widows Support Group in your church? Based on our experience, an effective ministry begins with the five steps listed below. The initial steps will take approximately four months to complete. It is important that you take your time and complete these steps before your first meeting.

FIVE STEPS OF PREPARATION TO BEGIN A WIDOWS SUPPORT GROUP IN YOUR CHURCH

- 1. Pray/Seek guidance of the Holy Spirit
- 2. Begin to seek Pastoral and Deacon Leadership and Support.
- 3. Identify widows within your church.
- 4. Pray for a widow or woman who has compassion for widows to lead a Biblically-based Support Group.
- 5. Study and learn about grief.
