

SO, SOMEONE ANSWERED THE DOOR!

GOALS: **Primary**- Have a spiritual conversation, sharing Christ with resident.
Secondary- Invite them to a church service.

Script:

(While handing them our information and a tract)

"Hi, my name is _____ and I'm from Erlanger Baptist Church. We are out today walking around the neighborhood talking to people about the Lord and their relationship with Him."

If there is opportunity to continue:

"What's your name? Are you from here? Lived here long? Born and Raised?"

(Allow for 2-3 min conversation to connect.)

"So, _____, do you have any spiritual belief or church background?"

If, "Yes: I'm _____"

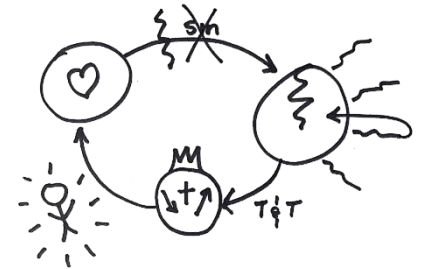
Then: **"Can you tell me how you believe someone gets to heaven?"** or **"What do your beliefs teach about how to have a relationship with God?"**

If, "Not Really."

"Could I have 3 minutes to share with you what the Bible says about a relationship with God?" or

"Would you allow me to show you what the Bible says about having a relationship with God?"

(3 Circles, Testimony, or Tract)



NOTE: This is not a sales pitch. In a sales pitch you should have all the details down and need all the answers. We are not trying to "close a deal," *we are introducing them to the opportunity to have a relationship with God.*

Every person will be at different points.

"I planted, Apollos watered, but God was causing the growth. So then neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but God who causes the growth." – 1 Corinthians 3:6

Regardless of how it goes, end it well.

"Thank you for your time. We would love for you to come join us for service at Erlanger Baptist Church. Before I leave, is there anything I could pray for you about?"

It's never going to be easy... but that is to be expected! Nothing is! But, you don't work alone!
