

2025 Worship Camp Electives

During the 2025 camp week, the elective format allows students to participate in two 2-hour electives and one 1-hour elective.

MUSICAL ELECTIVES

Acoustic Guitar Lab - Grab your guitar and learn the best practices and principles to enhance your skill.

Bass Guitar Lab - Take the next step in your ability to play bass guitar as part of a worship team.

Electric Guitar Lab - Electric guitar is one of the most versatile instruments in the band. Learn how to effectively use chords, lead lines, effects and more.

Guitar First Chords - This is for students who don't know anything about playing acoustic guitar but want to learn. Gain knowledge of the parts of guitar and take the first steps of learning a new instrument.

Drum Kit - Get hands on instructions to elevate your drumming skills. This will cover the drum kit only.

Hand Drums - Cajons and Djembes are common in modern band settings. Learn to play them with skill.

Music Theory - Dive deeper into a knowledge of chord progressions, harmonization, and other music theory basics.

Synthesizer - Explore how synthesizers can be used to enhance the sound of your worship band.

Vocal Techniques for Praise Band - For any vocalists to receive practical training to elevate their skills for singing in a group. Applied topics: tone, harmonizing, belting, ad-libing etc.

Worship Keys - Instructors will use hands-on instructions to help you contribute to your worship band from the piano/keyboard.



TECHNOLOGY ELECTIVES

Advanced Audio Concepts - This course will be a deep dive into fine-tuning your audio skills from microphone selection and placement to EQ'ing and compression to effects and layering them together allowing you to craft your mix!

Advanced Visual Arts - Explore how to use lights, screen formatting, and other visual aids in worship leadership.

ProPresenter Nuts and Bolts - Students will learn the basics of creating and working with presentations in ProPresenter. We'll break down ProPresenter to its most basic use, presenting lyrics. No prior knowledge or use needed for this elective.

Call to Ministry and Missions - Are you wrestling with a call to ministry? What happens next? Ask your questions here!

Hymnology - Learn to love the rich history of Christian hymnody and discover how the hymns of the past have shaped our worship today.

Navigating Conflict on Your Team - Working with and leading a team can be challenging. These practical tips will help you be prepared when conflict comes.

Song Writing and Production - Do you have a passion or desire to write songs for the church? In this elective you will learn some of the principles to guide your writing passion.

Strengthening Your Daily Quiet Time - What a worship leader does before the first note is critical. Learn how to enhance your private worship.

Teaching Music to Children - Want to use your passion and gifts for worship to disciple the next generation. This elective will give you the tools to do just that.

Women in Ministry - Hear from women who are serving in ministry now and discuss where and how women can serve in the church.

Worship Leadership - This elective will help the worship leader or planner think through leading a team, running a rehearsal and planning a song set and gain skills to execute a service with confidence.
